**2. Take Action!** I pledge to select at least two of the following Action Ideas and ensure that they are implemented at my organization.

- Participate in the national "Give 5-Save Lives" campaign.
  - Choose three dates.
  - Tell your employees that the first five minutes of their shift on those three days will be set aside for them to consider registering as a donor-either by going to our online email link ([donatelifewisconsin.org](http://donatelifewisconsin.org)) or by signing their driver's license or state issued I.D. card.

Note: To ensure their intent to donate is part of their DMV record, everyone is encouraged to log-in and register as a donor-even those who already have an orange donor dot on their license or state I.D.
- Send an email, voice or paper message from the CEO to all employees announcing your organization's commitment to the *Donate Life* campaign.
- Distribute or display donor dots and educational materials in a place your employees frequent. (Lunch/break rooms, bathrooms, conference rooms.)
- Post a Web banner that links to our state's Web site or DMV on your organization's Internet and Intranet. Go to [www.akoyaonline.com/wpfl/donatelife.htm](http://www.akoyaonline.com/wpfl/donatelife.htm) to view the banner options.
- Host an educational program for employees. Invite donors, recipients, donor family members and donation professionals to address employees at a meeting or seminar, health fair or brown-bag lunch session. Coalition members will be happy to assist, and can provide donation information and donor cards or computer access to our link at [donatelifewisconsin.org](http://donatelifewisconsin.org).
- Place an article in your company newsletter featuring a donation story and highlighting your organization's involvement in the *Donate Life* campaign. Articles are included in this packet, and are available online at [donatelifewisconsin.org](http://donatelifewisconsin.org). Click on the *Resources* link and then *Workplace Partnership for Life*.
- Provide orange "donor dot" stickers to your employees. Encourage discussion by asking employees to wear them on their nametags.
- Fly the Donate Life flag at your workplace. Go to [donatelife.net/catalog](http://donatelife.net/catalog) to order.
- Hold a blood drive or marrow drive at your worksite.
- Hold a driver's license or state I.D. card-signing event. Provide computers with Internet access so employees can go to [donatelifewisconsin.org](http://donatelifewisconsin.org).
- Implement a leave policy for employees who make a living donation.
- Enroll others in the campaign. Share information about the campaign with vendors, customers, partners, friends, club members, everyone!
